- A brief CV with photo, and your academic record to date
- State the degree or course you are enrolled in

- Your supervisor or the Head of Department must sign the application.

You must be enrolled in a tertiary institution within New Zealand for the duration of the award. Preference will be given to projects based in New Zealand and to Student Members of the Institute.

Award and Tenure: \$2,000 per scholarship for a 1-year term.
