The NZ Branch of the AusIMM invites papers and posters for the 2010 conference to be held in Auckland.

The conference is to celebrate NZ Mining and the contribution this important industry makes to the community through science, engineering and economic development. The AusIMM conference will follow the Geological Society of New Zealand Conference, including the NZ Geothermal Workshop, at the same venue (www.gsnz.org.nz for details; separate registration and payment). The combined occasion presents a unique and exciting opportunity, bringing together approximately 750 delegate professionals interested in earth sciences and the study and development of minerals, mining and energy related natural resources.

Presentations for the AusIMM conference are sought which particularly demonstrate innovation and productivity improvements through research, knowledge application, project development and commercial drive.

Topics to be covered include:

1. Geosciences, exploration potential and case histories
2. Mining – gold, coal, iron ore, base metals and industrial minerals
3. Finance, corporate and government relations for our mining industry
4. Geotechnical, geophysical and related aspects
5. Metallurgy and mineral processing
6. Environmental management
7. Legal and commercial issues

A full social programme, field trips, short courses and an accompanying person’s programme are planned.

Abstracts (up to 300 words) which summarise the scope and content of a paper or poster are requested by 31 May, 2010. Final papers are due 24 September 2010. Formatting guides for abstracts and papers are available from www.ausimm.co.nz. Abstracts and papers will be published in a proceedings volume available at the conference. Student papers are very welcome.
